TRAVEL TO TRUJILLO, PERU!

Bright Futures Peru is a non-profit charity organization that is recruiting Spanish-speaking student volunteers to work with at-risk children who attend a public elementary school located in the La Esperanza district of Trujillo, Peru.

Volunteers can work as teacher assistants in the classroom during school hours and tutoring kids one-on-one and in small groups after school.

Volunteering is a great opportunity to use your Spanish speaking abilities while doing important work helping at-risk kids.

Requirements:

- Must be a Spanish speaker (heritage or CEFR B1/B2 level).
- Volunteering is free, but the volunteer must cover their own expenses while in Peru. (approx. \$600 / month)
- Able to teach or tutor math, reading, writing, arts projects,
 & sports for elementary school students (1st 5th grade).
- Volunteer for 30 to 90 days in Peru.
- Have a passport.
